

Honda Goldwing Emergency Start Procedure



To perform the emergency start procedure, you will need:

- The emergency key (hidden inside your Smart Key)
 - The unlock code that came with your Smart Key (9-digit code)
 - Both saddlebags must be open
1. Remove the plastic protective panel above the license plate.
 2. Remove the emergency key from the Smart Key.
There is a small button on the side of the smart key, and when pressed, the emergency key will be ejected.
 3. Use the emergency key to unlock and open the left saddlebag lid.
 4. Pull on the cable ring at the top of the left saddlebag to unlock and open the right saddlebag.

We will be using the start/stop engine button (red button on right hand control) and the button at the top of the side pocket (right side of fairing).

Press and hold the start button for 4 seconds, until you hear a long beep. After you hear this beep, you will have 20 seconds to begin entering the emergency code.

1. Press the side pocket button the number of times equal to the first number on your emergency start code.
Example, if the emergency number is 436712345, the first number would be 4. In this example, we would press the side pocket button 4 times.
2. After entering the emergency code number, press the red start button to ENTER the number into the system.
IMPORTANT: If your emergency start number contains a zero (0), simply press the red start button again without pressing the side pocket button.
You will hear a short beep indicating that you have successfully entered the number.
3. Repeat steps 1-2 for each consecutive number in the emergency code

After successfully entering all numbers, your Goldwing electrical system should be activated and you should now be able to start your motorcycle.
